

The State of South Carolina doth know all men by these presents that I Abner B  
Greenville District<sup>rd</sup> Dunahoo of Greenville District and State aforesaid  
have constituted made and appointed and by these presents do constitute make  
and appoint John Dunahoo of the district and State aforesaid my true & lawful  
Attorney for me and in my name and stead and to my use to ask demand  
due for, levy and recover and receive all such sum and sums of money, debts  
rents goods wares dues accounts and other demands whatsoever which are or  
shall be due owing payable or belonging to me or detained from me in any manner  
of ways or means whatsoever by any person or persons whomsoever. Giving and  
granting unto my said attorney by these presents full and whole power strength  
and authority in my name and in my stead to have use and take all lawfull  
ways and means in my name for the recovery of any debts dues or sums of  
money aforesaid and upon the receipt of any such dues debts or sums of  
money aequittances or other sufficient discharge for me and in my name  
to make seal and deliver and generally all and every act or acts thing  
or things device or devices in the law whatsoever needful or necessary  
to be done in and about the recovery of any dues debts or sums of money  
as aforesaid for me and in my name to do execute and perform as fully  
legally and amply to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if  
I was personally present or as if the matter required more special authority  
than is herein given and attorney one or more under them for the purpose  
aforesaid to make and constitute and again at pleasure to revoke, ratifying  
allowing and holding for firm effect all and whatsoever my said attorney  
shall lawfully do in my name by virtue hereof.
