South Carolina & Know all men by these presents. That I. May. W.  
Greenville District, Lewis of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid  
for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred and Twenty  
three dollars, 75 per cent in hand paid by Margaret B. MacLom of the  
district in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said  
Margaret B. MacLom. All that tract or parcel of land parts originally  
granted to Henry MacLom and Josse Moody and now the residence  
of the said Mary W. Lewis containing by survey One hundred and seventy  
six acres, be the same more or less, having such boundaries marks &c  
as follows viz: Beginning at a stone corner on Jeremiah Cleveland's  
line, thence along the present lane N 83 E 53.50 chs to a stone corner  
thence S 54 E 22.25 chs to a stone + m on Cleveland's line, thence S 21 E 60  
10<sup>ds</sup> to a stone on the Branch, thence down the meanders of the Branch  
to a stone + m at the lower end of a ditch on Cleveland's line, thence  
along said line N 59 W 46.25 to a Pine corner, thence N 58 E 16 chs  
to a stone 3x thence N 27 E West 90 links to the Beginning,  
which said lands are parts of grants made to Henry MacLom and  
Josse Moody as aforesaid, the said Mary W. Lewis reserving one acre  
around the grave yard which is reserved as a family burying  
ground. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident  
or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the  
premises before mentioned, unto the said Margaret B. MacLom  
her heirs and assigns forever. And I. do hereby bind myself my  
Heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever  
defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said  
Margaret B. MacLom her heirs and assigns, against myself and  
my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same or any part thereof.
