Greenville District } that J. Larkin C. Reynolds of

the State of District aforesaid in consideration of the discharge of a Court Judge-
ment in favour of J. Roberts & others to myself and forty Dollars to me in
hand by Henry Darby of the same State and District have granted bargain
and sold on by three presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry
Darby his heirs and assigns for ever a certain plantation or tract of land situated
lying and being in District aforesaid on both sides of the middle fork of Saluda
River containing One Hundred and fifty acres more or less including the mouths of Fall
and Cap Creeks, beginning on a conditional line to run strait with the top of the hill
where the road crosses including all the land sold to said Reynolds by Greenberry
Capps being west of said hill bounded by St. Crook and Jesse Mayfields & others
having such shape and marks as shall hereof with show together with all and
singular the said premises unto the said Henry Darby his heirs and assigns for ever
and I undertake myself and heirs and assigns to warrant and for ever defend
the same unto the said Henry Darby his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs for
ever. In witness hereof I set my hand and affix my seal this the thirty first day of
March in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight and forty Two. Signed Seal &
