 grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert Cox all our right title interest and
 estate in and to All that parcel or Lots of Land situated in the village of Greenville
 and District aforesaid known formerly as W. T Rowlands tavern Lots and more recent-
 ly as the property of B. Ligow of which said property we the said John Moon and James
 Harr together with the said Robert Cox have been up to the date of these presents joint
 owners and proprietors which said lots are described as follows viz the lot on main
 street whereon was situated the Tavern commencing at the south corner of Beatties stone lot and
 running thence S. 16. W. with main street to the corner of said street and Washington street thence
 along the line of Washington street 220 feet more or less to the corner of said street and Lawrence
 street thence along the line of Lawrence street to P. Cambles corner thence along the line of Cambles
 lot to Beatties stone lot thence along Beatties line to the beginning corner on main street
 also the lot part of the said property whereon is situated the stables attached to the said
 Tavern lot being the entire square marked as Lots No. 18 and 20 in McBur's plan of said
 Village bounded on the East by Lawrence street South by Washington street West by Richard-
 son street and North by Coffe street the first mentioned lot herein described being
 part of a lot marked as No. 17 in McBur's plan of said Village Together with all and
 singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging or in any wise incident and appertaining To have and to hold all and
