 hand by John J. Bennet of the same State and District have bargained
 sold and released and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto
 the said John J. Bennet his Heirs or assigns a tract or parcel of Land in
 said District on Cripple Creek of Reedy River containing One
 hundred and sixty acres be the same more or less. Beginning at a rock
 on Hendersons line thence S. 25. W. 30. to a rock on Huffs corner thence
 S. 68. E. 71. to a stone Thomasons corner thence N. 25. E. 19. 83. to a stake Thom-
 asons corner thence N. 68. W. 36. 50. to a stake thence on Coys line N. 45. W. 37
 to the beginning. A part of which Land being originally granted to Richard
 Lancaster the other part originally granted to Peter Swiny. to have and to
 hold the same as above described to the said John J. Bennet his Heirs and
 assigns forever together with all rights members hereditaments and appurte-
 nances belonging or incident to the same. and we do hereby bind ourselves
 our Heirs and assigns to warrant and defend the said premises against
 ourselves our Heirs and assigns and against all persons legally claiming the
