Archibald Richards Deed of Sale of Quiet Claim 83

 Greenville District $\frac{3}{3}$ by these presents
 that I Archibald J. Richards of Greenville District and State aforesaid for
 and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by
 Yardly M. Bee of the State and District aforesaid have this day bargained sold
 and conveyed unto the said Yardly M. Bee a certain piece or parcel of Land
 which is supposed to be within the lines of a tract of Land owned by the
 said Yardly by a purchase from Samuel A. Alston & likewise by a grant
 from the State of South Carolina dated 12th day of July A. D. 1831 as appear
 of record. The Land hereby conveyed begins at a Dogwood tree runs North 45 degrees
 West 20 chains to a Stake thence South 50 West 7 chains Stake thence N. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$
 W. 58.25 to a Stake thence S. 27 W. 24 Ch. thence S. 84 E. 58.25 to the beginning
 supposed to contain about Seventy four acres be the same more or less
 the land not being now pretended to be measured as this is a contract
 entirely of compromise of this conveyance made to put an entire stop
 to all altercation here after as it is fully known that the said Yardly
 titles covers the same lands and this is made as an entire quiet claim
 to any and all lands that might intersect within the boundary of the
 said Yardlys land either granted to Kerr Co or Lewis Hector which grants
 were supposed to intersect but if they do intersect this conveyance
 conveys all the land within the said Yardly's boundary of no more,
 hereby conveyed to the said Yardly M. Bee his heirs and assigns all
 the entire interest I have or ever had in the above described Land
 from me and my heirs forever but no further as it is only intended
