I Prew B Benson of the State and District aforesaid for the consideration of twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by Marshal Shetton of the said District and State aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Marshal Shetton and his Heirs one tract of Land containing fifteen acres of land be the same more or less; bounded as follows. Viz, beginning at a stake corner at the fork of the road John Crawford and Silas Bensons lines, thence along said road to a white oak, at the ford of the cattail branch, thence up said branch with meanders of said branch to the spring to a stake corner at the head of said spring on the old line of said S Benson and M Shetton, thence S. 17. W. to a post-oak corner thence E. 57° C 4 chains and 50. links to the beginning together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said Marshal Shetton and his Heirs forever and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs or assigns &c to warrant and forever defend the above described land for use and purpose before mentioned unto the said Marshal Shetton from me or my Heirs or assigns forever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have set my hand. Hereunto affixed my seal this seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two, Signed sealed and delivered in presence of us.
