Together with all & singular the premises with its appurtenances unto the same belonging or in any wise incident, or pertaining. To Have and To Hold, all & singular the said premises with its appurtenances unto the said Cherris C. Montgomery his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and admrs, to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises, with the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances unto the said Cherris C. Montgomery his heirs & assigns, against myself & my heirs and every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof, Witness my hand and Seal, this June 15<sup>th</sup> One thousand eight hundred forty one, Signed, sealed & delivered in the presence of
