Pickett, and the title made by the Sheriff to Septima B. Pickett, son and conveyed by him to Abner P. Charlton and that sold by the Sheriff and the title made by the Sheriff to the said Septima B. Pickett and James C. Pickett & now sold and conveyed by the said Septima B. Pickett & James C. Pickett to the sd, James Pickett aforesaid. Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments & appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said James Pickett, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said James Pickett his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
