in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold & released, and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
James T. Moon, all that tract or plantation of Land, Contain-
ing one hundred and seventy three acres be the same more or less
adjoining land of James Ross, W. Stuart & others, on Beaver
Creek, waters of Middle Tyger River, being the same whereon
William St. Moon now lives, and conveyed to me by W. M. Goodlett,
Sheriff bearing date the 6th day of April 1840 and recorded in
Book F. Pages 484 & 485 - Together with all and singular the
Rights, members, Hereditaments & appurtenance, to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining -
To have and hold, all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said James T. Moon his heirs and assigns
forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Adminis-
trators to warrant forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said James T. Moon his heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs - Witness my hand & Seal this fifth
day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and forty three, & 67th year of the Independence of the United States
of America - Signed, sealed & delivered in the presence
of, W. St. Moon & Elizabeth Blasingame *W. Blasingame Seal*
South Carolina & Personally appeared Elizabeth Blasingame
Greenville District before me and made oath she did see
William Blasingame sign, Seal and as his acts
and deed deliver the within deed for the use and pur-
