

of Two hundred Dollars paid to me in hand by Lewis H Dickey of the
District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said Lewis H Dickey a tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the District of Greenville aforesaid on Sugar river and
Morgans Creek being a part of three tracts of land which is desig-
nated by James McDaniel Deed as Sheriff to William Johnson
containing Three hundred and thirty acres more or less there
being fifty acres excepted which Esias Dill now lives on bound-
ed by a cross fence between said Dill and Johnson also by
John Masons land Edward Dills land John Hensons land and
John Dills land containing by estimation two hundred and
eighty acres more or less it being a part of several tracts together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertain-
ing thereto to have and to hold the above mentioned premises unto
the said Lewis Dickey his heirs and assigns forever and for
myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns do warrant
and defend the above mentioned premises unto the said Lewis H
Dickey or his heirs executors administrators or assigns or against
myself my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness
