Greenville District, Know all men by these presents, that I, Vandy Mcbee, of the District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to me paid by Lydia Hornbuckle of the same State and District, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lydia Hornbuckle a certain Lot or stripe of Land bounded by said Lydia Hornbuckle's and John Matson, Esq. lots on the Pendleton Road, opposite Mrs. Hamison near the Town of Greenville and bounded as follows; viz. Beginning at the corner of said Lydia Hornbuckle's lot thence with said lot on the East side S. 22° E. 378 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the corner of said Matson's lot on said Road, thence N. 68° E. 10 feet to a stone corner, thence N. 22° W. 378 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stone corner thence S. 68° W. 10 feet to the beginning, with a full right of ingress and egress to said road always, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold the said Lot of Land to the said Lydia Hornbuckle her heirs and assigns forever.
