Greenville District. Then presents, that

I, Peadiah Cook, of the State aforesaid, in
consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear towards
my two sons John and William Cook, hath given and granted and
by these presents doth grant unto the said John Cook and William
Cook, their heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land where-
on the said Peadiah Cook now lives containing Three Hundred and fifty
Acres more or less, as is represented on a plat surveyed by Mr. C.
Cunningham the second day of March, 1840 - to be equally di-
vided betwixt the said John Cook and William Cook the dividing
line to commence on Thomas Coopers Land and run an East course to
Thomas Austins Land and John Cook to have all the land on the North
side of the dividing line, and William Cook to have all the land on
the South side of said line (with a reserved right to the land and pre-
mises to the said Peadiah Cook, during his natural life) and I, the
said Peadiah Cook, do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and
administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
Land and premises unto the said John and William Cook, their heirs and
assigns against all claims that now is and against every person whomo-
ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness
