Know all men by these presents, that I, Green Bradley, of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, in consideration of Two hundred and sixteen dollars to me paid by William Choice of Greenville Village in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William Choice all that tract and parcel of land lying and being situate in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the waters of Armstrong's Creek of Saluda River beginning on a white oak 3 x thence S. 58 E. 20 to a white oak 3 x thence N. 61 E. 21 to a lightwood knot 3 x thence N. 15 E. 28.50 to Black Gum 3 x thence N. 30 E. 7.70 to dead red oak 3 x thence N. 33 W. 5 to White Oak 3 x thence along a branch line 27 to a stake 3 x finally white oak thence along the branch line 34 to the beginning corner together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Choice his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Choice his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
