



District on the South side of South Tyger River, being the same land conveyed to me by James May, containing two hundred and fifteen acres be the same more or less, known as the 'Craine place' for a more particular reference see Plat annexed, reserving to May the rights of high water marks of the water of his mill pond as the dam now stands and in the event of the abandonment of the mill for the sum of twelve months he has not the right to rebuild ~~and~~ with the consent of said Craine, also one other tract of land conveyed to May by Wesley Gilbreath from May to Samuel Craine and from Samuel Craine to William Craine being a part of said Gilbreath's Father's old tract adjoining the above, containing Seventy acres be the same more or less for a more particular reference see the plat annexed Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Craine his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Craine his heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs and against every person whosoever lawfully claims the same in any part thereof.
