

Pool in the whole two hundred and twenty four acres all that here described the premises together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Martin H. Jones his heirs and assigns for ever & the sd John P. Pool do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Martin H. Jones his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person wheresoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Witness our hands and seals this 27 day of December in the year of our Lord 1844 and in the sixty eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
