

of two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Minor C. Lankford of the same state and district all my interest in certain tract or parcels of Land (it being one half of said tract conveyed to myself and Nathan H. Lankford by Lewis H. Edwards) situated in the state and District above named on both sides of Motteys Creek waters of South Pacolet River beginning at Black oak on the south side of said creek running thence N 14 W 84 chains crossing said creek to a pine tree south 73° E 33 chains crossing a branch to a post oak thence S 4 E 75 chains to a black oak thence S 61 E 15 chains to the begining containing one hundred and thirty five acres be the same more or less to have and to hold all and singular the right titles hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators for ever to warrant and defend the above sd interest in said land unto the said Minor C. Lankford his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs and assigns and against the lawful claim of all other persons claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 1st day of December A. D. one thousand eight hundred and forty five.
