said State and District, and we do hereby authorize and con-  
fer power the said Charles C. Garrison to receive from any per-  
son in whose hands the same may be, all amounts due to  
us by virtue of our interest or estate in any of the real  
and personal estate of the said John Jones dec'd. and ratify  
his receipts for the same against us and our heirs for-  
ever.
