


Austin; thence S. 21 W. one hundred fifty feet to a stake; thence S. 73 E. two hundred & forty four feet to a stake; thence N. 17 E. one hundred & fifty feet to the beginning corner, be the quantity more or less, within the said bounds: Together with all and singular the rights, members, & appurtenances, thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, & the reversion and reversions, remainder & remainders, rents, issues, & profits thereof; To have & to hold the said Tract or lot of Land with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph H. Headden his Heirs & assigns forever.

Provided always nevertheless, if it is the true intent & meaning of the parties to these presents, that if the said Warren Goddard, his Heirs, Execs or admrs shall well & truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said Joseph Headden the sum of Four Hundred Dollars with interest according to the tenor & effect of the notes above mentioned, then & from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null & void; any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding. And it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents, that until default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth & the interest for the same, it shall & may be lawful to & for the said Warren Goddard, peaceably & quietly to hold, use, occupy, possess, & enjoy all & singular the premises above granted, & released, of every part thereof, with the appurtenances, & to have, receive & take the rents; issues, & profits thereof to his own particular use & behoof; any thing herein contained to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding.
