presents that I George Bain of District  
and State aforesaid for and in Con-

sideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty Dollars to me paid  
by William Bain of District & State aforesaid, have granted, bar-  
gained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said William Bain a certain tract of land Con-  
taining Twenty seven acres (more or less) Situate in Greenville Dis-  
trict on Reedy River beginning on a Maple 3 x 3 x on bank of the  
River Thence on lands of James Bain S. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 35.50 to a Dog-  
wood 3 x Thence on lands of George Bain Junr. N 57 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 7.05 to  
a Rock 3 x in old field Thence N. 40 W. 40 chs on lands of Hi-  
num Baldwin to a stone 3 x Thence S. 50 W. on John Bain's line to  
a Stake on Bank of the River Thence down said River bound-  
ed on the middle of said river to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members,  
hereditaments and Appertenances to the said premises belonging  
or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Wil-  
liam Bain his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind
