situation and not for any thing else and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
and administrators or assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
said premises during the said space of Fifteen years unto the said Thomas A. Dean
Tilman Miller and W. Henderson Esq. and then to fall back to me the said Lemuel L
Henderson his heirs Executors or assigns or witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this Fifteenth day of December in the year of Our Lord One thousand
eight hundred and forty seven and in the seventy first year of American Independence

ation of the sum of Six Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Isaac Dean of
the District and State before mentioned have granted, bargained, sold & released and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Isaac Dean, all
that parcel of Tract of Land containing One Hundred and Twenty eight acres as
surveyed and platted by John Young on the 1st Oct. 1806 lying and being in the
District and State aforesaid, on Brushy Creek Waters of Shady River, beginning
at a Black Gum on Brushy Creek, running thence N 28° 44'. 50 to a Red Oak
