Joseph McGoodwin of the District and  
State aforesaid for and in Consideration

of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by William C Goodwin  
have Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
sell and release unto the said William C Goodwin his heirs and assigns forever  
all my interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land which is one half situated in  
said District on the North Bank of Saluda River containing Five hundred and fifty  
two acres more or less it being a part of a tract of land conveyed by Joseph Goodwin  
to myself and William C Goodwin and known as the Ford place The part or tract  
now to be conveyed has such bounds or marks as follows Viz Beginning at a white  
3x near the said river, thence S. 44° E 44.50 chs to a light wood knob 3x on the original  
line of a grant made to John Ford, thence on same original line N 8 W 44 chs to  
a stake 3x on a branch, thence S 85 W 22.50 chs to a sycamore 3x on the South line  
of said tract of Saluda River thence up the meanders of said River to the  
mouth of a creek called Campfield about 34 chs, thence up the meanders of said  
creek about 30 chs to a chestnut 3x thence S. 9 E 7 chs to a red oak 3x thence  
S. 44 W 29.20 chs to a red oak 3x thence S 25 W 8.20 chs to a post oak 3x thence  
S 69 E 37.50 chs to a white oak 3x on the North bank of said river, thence up  
the meanders of said river in a direct line bearing about S 67 E to the beginning con-
