S 62 E 24.25 to a rocke 3 x 3 mm Thence along said road N 13 40' 25.36 to a  
rocke 3 x 3 mm Thence N 3° W. 5.75 to the beginning rocke corner

to them and to hold all and singular the above described premises unto the
