

Joseph Brown To John McKittrick	Dec'd 130 Acres	State of South Carolina I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that S. Joseph Brown of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina in consideration
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of the sum of Three hundred and Sixty dollars to me paid by John McKittrick of the same State, have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said John McKittrick a certain tract of land situated in said District on the under Mountain Creek of Chee river containing One hundred and Thirty acres, it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Isaac Green and has such bounded marks &c as follows: Beginning at a pine stump 3x near the Rutherford road, Thence N 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 14 rods to a white oak 3x on a branch Thence down said branch N 80 E. 6.50 rods to a maple 3x Thence N 82 E. 9.40 rods to a Past oak 3x Thence N 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 11.55 rods to a chestnut 3x Thence N 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 13.82 rods to a Slack oak sapling 3x Thence N 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 13.25 rods to a Chestnut 3x near the Spring Thence N 85 W 36.00 rods to a red oak 3x Thence S 12 W 19.10 rods to a fallen down pine 3x Thence S 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 15.81 rods to a Hickory stake 3x Thence N 81 E 15.00 rods to the beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to them and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John McKittrick his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John McKittrick his heirs and assigns and against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
