of Horse Creek. Beginning on an Ash 3X on said creek, running Thence  
W 25° E 8.00 to Stake 3X Horse W 50° E 44.60 to a Stake 3X Bounding on John  
Gambrel and Elizabeth Gains land Thence S 40° E. 21.00 to a Stake 3X  
on said Sullivans' Land Thence down the meanders of a Branch 8.00  
to a maple 3X Thence up the Branches of a fork of said branch 12.00 to a  
maple 3X Thence S 50° W 62.00 to a Dogwood 3X on line creek binding on Archy  
Johnson's land Thence up the meanders of said creek to the beginning
