 any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and sing-
 lar the premises before mentioned unto the said William H. Watson
 and his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and sing-
 lar the premises aforesaid unto the said William H. Watson his heirs and
 assigns against myself my heirs and against every person or persons whom-
 soever lawfully claiming a to claim the same or any part thereof.
