by my note under seal of equal date with these presents stand firsty indebted  
to Joseph A Whitmire in the sum of Sixteen hundred and Twenty nine Dollars  
specie with interest from the first of January last payable one month after  
date Hereunder Ye I thank I the said James A Harrison for the  
better securing the payment of the said sum of Sixteen hundred and Twenty  
nine Dollars specie unto the said S. A Whitmire his heirs executors, adminis-  
-trators assigns, together with lawful interest for the same and in consideration  
of one dollar paid I James A Harrison there bargained and sold and by  
these presents do bargain and sell and in plain and open market deliver  
unto the said Joseph A Whitmire the following negro slaves To Wm Martha  
a woman about Twenty years of age and two children Eliza then yeare old  
Emily two years old and an infant one month, Clarissa a woman about twenty  
five years old To Hiram and to Lot the said Negroes slaves and their further  
increase unto the said Joseph A Whitmire his executors, administrators and  
assigns forever Provided Always nevertheless That if the said  
James A Harrison his heirs executors, administrators or assigns shall  
and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Joseph A  
Whitmire his certain attorney executors administrators or assigns the full  
and just sum of Sixteen hundred and Twenty nine Dollars specie according to  
the true intent and meaning of the note under seal aforesaid and of these presents  
together with lawful interest thereon then this deed of bargain and sale and all  
and every clause article therein contained shall cease determine and be utterly
