

The State of South Carolina To all whom  
These Presents shall come Greeting Wheras I the said Henry C Brigg  
doe owe to Soak Mouldin in the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars  
by Sealed note dated the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 1849 and payable twelve months after  
date Now I know all men That I the said Henry C Brigg doe and in consideration  
of the said Sealed note aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
Soak Moulding and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me the  
the said Henry C Brigg in hand well and truly paid by the said Soak Mouldin  
at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof is fully ac-  
nowledged I the said Henry C Brigg have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these Presents doth Grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Soak Mouldin  
all that Tract or parcel of Land Situated lying and being in Pickens District  
in the State aforesaid on Dusty Creek Branches of Saluda River containing  
Six Hundred and Seventy Acres more or less Adjoining lands of John Cen-  
tackshanks John Conckle Redick Conckle May A Hamilton died Hearnsor  
Abel et al being the same Tract of Land which was sold and conveyed by  
Williams C Brige to Philip S Buttledge and by him sold and conveyed to  
me by deed of even date with these Presents

I doe this with all and singular the Rights Members  
and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or  
pertaining To Have and to Hold all and singular the said Premises  
unto the said Soak Mouldin his Heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby  
bind myself my Heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend  
all and singular the said Premises unto the said Soak Mouldin his and  
assigns from and against myself my Heirs executors administrators and assigns  
and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

Provided always Nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning  
of the parties to these Presents That if I the said Henry C Brigg do and  
shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Soak Mouldin the  
amount of the sealed note aforesaid with interest thereon if any shall be due acc-  
ording to the true intent and meaning of the said Sealed Note then this bond of  
bargain and sale shall cease determine and be utterly null and void otherwise  
it shall remain in full force and virtue And it is agreed by and between the said  
parties that the said Henry C Brigg is to have and enjoy the said premises until  
default of payment shall be made

the 74<sup>th</sup> year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of
