 To Greenville District  
 E. B. Clark Land From all men by these Presents that I Rufus  
 Oats for and in consideration of the sum of Three  
 Hundred and Six Dollars to me in hand paid by Mrs Eleanor B Clark  
 of John H. Clarke the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged have granted here-  
 gained released sold and conveyed and by these presents do Grant Bargain release  
 sell and convey unto Elias Bramlett Trustee of the said Mrs Eleanor B Clark  
 in Trust for the exclusive use benefit and advantage of the said Eleanor B  
 Clark The following Tracts pieces or parcels of land situated lying and being  
 in the District and State aforesaid on a small branch of Reedy River the first  
 Tract containing One Hundred and Ninety two Acres more or less bounded by lands  
 of the Wm Ashurst the late James McKenzie Isaac Cox Samuel Hicks  
 and John Smith Commencing on Smith's Land on the Mill road thence  
 down the said road to a pine stump corner on McKenzie land thence S<sup>E</sup>W<sup>N</sup> 13.50 to a Stake on the branch thence up the said branch to a maple tree  
 \$14 N in chains to a stake thence S<sup>W</sup>W<sup>E</sup> on said leaf line to a post oak on Hick's  
 land thence thence on said Hicks line to a stake on Smith's land thence on  
 Smith's line to the beginning Originally granted to John Coffey Also one other  
 Tract Situated in the District aforesaid joining the tract above described con-  
 taining Fifteen Acres more or less Originally granted to Samuel Hicks the first  
 day of December 1817 as will be seen by reference to the grant and plat aforesaid  
 and will now fully appear Beginning at Post Oak and running thence  
 S<sup>W</sup>W<sup>E</sup> 37.50 to a black gum thence S<sup>W</sup>W<sup>E</sup> 7.50 to a Stake and thence N<sup>E</sup>W<sup>S</sup>  
 43.50 to the beginning

Together with all and singular the menses hereditaments  
 and appurtenances to the said Tracts of land belonging or in anywise incident  
 or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned  
 unto the said Elias Bramlett in Trust for the exclusive benefit and advantage  
 of the said Mrs Eleanor B Clark who is to have use occupy and enjoy the said prop-  
 erty free from hindrance by the said Elias Bramlett Trustee as aforesaid or any other  
 person for and during her natural life and at her death the said premises to  
 belong of right in fee simple to the lineal heirs of the said Eleanor B Clark  
 And I hereby bind myself to warrant and defend the said premises against me  
 and my heirs unto the said Elias Bramlett in Trust as aforesaid but against  
 no other claim whatever
