Roberts do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said debt a sum of money aforesaid and the interest thereon according to the true intent and meaning of the said Note then this deed of bargain shall cease and determine and be utterly null and void otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue.
