Waddy Thompson To R. B. Duncan & W. S. Roberts	Mortgage For Land	State of South Carolina This Indenture made the twenty second day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty between Mr John Thompson of Greenville County in the said State of the one part and Robert B. Duncan and William S. Roberts Executors of the last will and Testament of John McRoberts deceased of the other part Witnesseth Whereas the said Waddy Thompson hath become indebted to the said Robert B. Duncan and William S. Roberts Executors as aforesaid in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars by sealed Note dated the 27 <sup>th</sup> of March 1850 and payable the day after date and also in the further sum of One Thousand Dollars by another sealed note dated the 27 <sup>th</sup> of March 1850 payable twelve months after date with interest from date
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Now this Indenture Witnesseth That the said Waddy Thompson  
for and in consideration of the said debt or sum payable as aforesaid and for the better securing  
the payment thereof to the said Robert B. Duncan and William S. Roberts Executors as aforesaid  
according to the time and effect of the two sealed notes aforesaid and also in consideration  
of the sum of Five Dollars by the said Robert B. Duncan and William S. Roberts Executors  
as aforesaid to the said Waddy Thompson in hand paid at and before the sealing and  
delivery of these presents do grant lease, sell, alien, release and confirm unto the said  
Robert B. Duncan and William S. Roberts and to their Heirs and Assignees all  
that piece parcel and tract of Land containing One hundred and forty nine Acres  
more or less of which the aforesaid John McRoberts deceased did seized and possess  
situated lying and being in Greenville District in the State aforesaid on Hickland  
creek waters of Ruddy River bounded by Lands of Gen Waddy Thompson Revd J.  
Burst Rock C. B. Stone W. Choice and D. H. Pendleton and more fully described  
in a deed of Conveyance for the same made by the said R. B. Duncan and W. S.  
Roberts as Executors aforesaid to the said Waddy Thompson of even date with these  
presents the purchase money of which to the above sealed notes and this Mortgage is intended  
to secure

Together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion or reversionary  
remainders rents issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the said tract of  
Land with the appurtenances unto the said Robert B. Duncan and William S. Roberts and  
their heirs and assigns forever provided always nevertheless and in a like intent and  
meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said Waddy Thompson his heirs  
executors or Administrators shall well and truly pay a cause to be paid unto the said  
Robert B. Duncan and William S. Roberts the sum of Three Thousand  
Dollars and the interest which may accrue thereupon according to the two
