I know ye that in consideration of your integrity and shall fully give and
to you a power to take the relinquishment of Elizabeth Hawkins wife
of Joseph Hawkins of Crawford County of Missouri of her estate interest and
inheritance in the premises described in the annexed Deed of Conveyance to Oliver P. Phillips
of Greenville District State of South Carolina dated 12th January 1850 conveying
the interest of her husband Joseph Hawkins and herself in a Tract of Land situated
in Greenville District State of South Carolina containing Six Hundred and Twenty
two Acres more or less. And for this purpose you will cause the said Elizabeth Hawkins
to appear before you and you will examine her privately and separately apart from all
other persons and if upon such examination she shall freely declare that she did at
least seven days before such examination actually give her husband in executing the
said Deed aforsaid that the said release was freely and bona fide executed
less than seven days before such examination and that she did then at the execution
of the said release and still does at the time of examination freely voluntarily and without
any manner of compulsion due to fear of any person or persons whomsoever to make
release and further relinquish all her estate interest and inheritance in the premises
mentioned and conveyed in the said release unto the said Oliver P. Phillips and his heirs
and assigns. I then you shall take under her Hand a certificate of her examination
and relinquishment as aforesaid in the form of a Declaration upon private examination
as aforesaid which certificate unauthenticated by your hands and seals you shall annex to this
will. And you are also freely compelled to take probate of the execution of
the said Deed and for this purpose you shall cause one of the subscribing witnesses of
the said Deed to appear before you and having administered to him as you are freely fully
authorized to do and oath or solemn affirmation according to the form of his religious
persuasion that the affiant is true you shall take under her Hand an affidavit that he
was personally present and saw Joseph C. Hawkins and Elizabeth Hawkins his wife sign
the said Deed aforesaid in the way and manner therein expressed and that he and
the other subscribing witness signed this writing thereat as witness of its due Execution
which affiant authenticates under your hands and seals you shall annex to this will
