Dollars and fifty cents to me in hand paid by Ervin Ward of the State and District aforesaid  
mention'd Name Granted Bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant  
Bargain and release unto the said Ervin Ward a certain Tract or parcel of Land con-  
taining Nineteen Acre of Land to the same more or less, lying on the waters of  
Fall Creek and on the waters of North Saluda River Beginning on a Chestnut on  
Ervin Ward's Line running South 54 West 37 chains and so Sunk to a dog Wood thence  
North 77 West 17 chains by links to a Spanish Oak thence along Ervin Ward Line to  
the beginning. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Inheritances  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident a pertaining  
To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
Ervin Ward his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors  
and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises  
unto the said Ervin Ward his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against any  
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

of the State of South Carolina and Greenville District  
of the one party and Ervin Ward of the State and District  
of aforesaid of the other party Witnesseth that for and in considera-

tion of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt is fully acknowl-  
edged both Bargained sold and delivered and do by these presents Bargained sell and deliver  
unto Ervin Ward a certain Tract of Land containing one hundred acres more or less  
lying in the State and District of aforesaid being on to the sides of Fall Creek Beginning on  
the conditional line between Phillips and said John Headon thence along the old line  
till it comes against the mouth of the Little thence up the little branch a north west  
course to the old original line thence to the beginning came.

To have and to hold all and singular the woods trees waters and  
waters courses profits pasturage hereditaments and appurtenances the said John Headon
