In State aforesaid to and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred Dollars to me paid by Genl. Genl. & Genl. in the state than aforesaid bargained  
and released unto these presents do grant bargain & sell and release unto  
the said Genl. Genl. & Genl. Thomas M. Cox a parcel of land in the  
Village of Greenville with the improvements thereon Beginning at a Stake  
in the road on Main Street and running up Main Street At 17 degrees East  
each to an iron Stake corner of Mr. Watson's lot thence 173 degrees West  
and due North 175 feet along the line of the said Watson's lot to a rock corner thence 174 degrees  
West 175 feet to a corner on the side of lot thence 173 degrees East 174 degrees  
and due South to the Stake in the road on Main Street the beginning being one known and  
designated as Lot No. 3 South West corner in the plan of the village  
Surveyed by Surveyor M. G. Cox to George Flinn. The time of Survey 1821  
to George Flinn to Thomas M. Cox the 20<sup>th</sup> August 1833 was the sum the  
lot conveyed by Surveyor M. G. Cox to the M. Cox the 21<sup>st</sup> Sept 1844 by the  
said lot or Main. It is 174<sup>th</sup> days

to the said Genl. Genl. & Genl. their Heirs and Assignees against me and my  
heirs made against every person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part thereof
