Stake on said River East 50 chains to a Stake on Spartaburgh Line Stone with 50
feet from same Northw 40 degrees East Stake with his Stone No 27 N 15 E.
State Stone to the Beginning Containing Sixty Five acres and two rods
the same more or less it being a tract deeded by Colton Collier to John Hough
and he do hereby warrant and further defend the aforesaid premises unto the said Young
Shields his heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs and assigns and against
every other person lawfully claiming the same.
