This is a certificate and agreement upon by and between the parties that until default shall be made in payment of the above sum as before mentioned and the interest on the same it shall and may be lawful for the said Farmer McNeely am & equally to let & possess all and singular the above mentioned personal property and any part thereof

In case of default herein made in payment of the sum aforesaid it shall and may be lawful for the said Master McNeely to enter my premises and take the possession of the said property to convert the same to his own use or sell the same and after paying his liabilities unto the said Master Farmer the balance he is to pay over to the said Farmer Duncan any thing therein contained contrary in any wise notwithstanding
