Where all men by these presents that Willis Sinson of the District and State aforesaid for value received in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and twenty five dollars to me paid by William Jacobs of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargained sell and release unto the said William Jacobs one half of that Tract of Land lying situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid lying on the waters of Saluda River bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a pine down on the main road leading to Wilson Ferry and running S 20° W 45° to a tree near the Middle line Thence S 30° E 30' to a Stake or Garrison line Then N 68° E 30' to a Stake Thence to a Blk oak tree Thence N 30° W 32' to a Blck oak tree Then N 45° W 32' to a Stake Thence N 45° W 32' Thence to the Star beginning corner containing one hundred and nineteen acres and no part more or less of an acre more or less of land.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, chattels, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging now or any time hereafter or appearing.

I do hereby and to the best of my knowledge and belief make and declare unto the said William Jacobs his heirs or assigns of record I do hereby and declare myself executor, administrator and assignee to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Jacobs his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs and assigns and against and against every person who shall hereafter lawfully claim any part thereof.
