S 14° 18' 16" E 20 chl. to a sycamore 37 1/4 ft. 30 chl. to a live Oak. thence
S 14° 18' 16" E 20 chl. to a pine 3x6 in. in dia. thence N 29° E 29 chl. to the
beginning or reference to flat mine of Washington Taylor & Sons, 11th 1851 and more
or less together with all and singular the rights, privileges, hereditaments
and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
thereunto and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said
Joseph Meunie his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my
heirs executors and administrators to me and my family to defend the said premises
