Presents I that John Holler of this District and State of South Carolina and in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars to me in hand paid by Rebecca Alcuniu have granted sold and released and by these presents do grant the said land and release unto the said Rebecca Alcuniu certain tract or lot of land containing Two and a half acres situated in this District and State and on a branch of Clark Creek waters of South Santee river the same being part of a tract of land formerly owned by poor Bruce dead who sold by his executor John M. Roberts to the High Sheriff of Horry John Phillips and by the said Sheriff to myself.

Beginning at a small white Oak 3x one near a Spring running SSW N 1.50 chs to another tree 82 1/4 to 12.25 chs to a Spanish Oak 3x one N 18 1/4 E 5.30 chs to fence 3x one 82 1/4 E 8.00 stone 3x one 85 3/4 E 2.25 chs to a Post Oak 3x one 82 1/4 W 13.88 chs to the Beginning

Sogether with all and singular the rights, incidents, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Rebecca Alcuniu her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Rebecca Alcuniu her heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof.
