Maytaylor in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, have granted and bargained, sold and released unto the said Ebenezer W. Gove and Maytaylor all their chose, justly parcel and tracts of Land, Situate, lying, and being in the District and State aforesaid and partly within the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville to wit Track No 1 Containing Sixty four (64) Acres more or less, being on the Western side of The Greenville and Columbia Rail Road, Lands Belitting and Boundary as follows: Beginning at a Stake of fifty feet west of the center of the Rail Road track and running thence with lands owned by The Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ M. Sixteen chains and fifteen links to a Stake of Thence with said lands and with lands owned by C. H.
