of Two Thousand Three Hundred and twenty five Dollars to  
me in hand paid has agreed to be paid by P. N. Fitch of the  
District aforesaid of Anderson and State aforesaid have granted his aym  
to sold and released and by these yourts do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said P. N. Fitch to him a parcel  
parcel of Land lying and being situated in the district aforesaid  
State aforesaid and on the East side of Saluda river between the  
described.

Beginning on a red oak pond running thence S 74 1/2 E 52.80 to  
a rock on the bank of the said thence N 30.00 E 31.71 to another  
thence S 10.60 W 25 to a pine thence S 45 deg 20' to a Turkey cock  
thence S 24 1/2 W 16 to a pine thence S 56.00 E 37.50 to a branch on the  
west fence up with the meanders of Saluda given to a beach  
thence N. 83 E. 12.20 to the beginning red oak.

This Pond is bounded by lands of John Richardson and James  
McWayne containing three hundred and twenty seven and  
one half acres more or less.

I give and warrant all and singular the premises (Exept 130 ft  
from the centre of the Greenville and Columbia rail road or one  
hundred ft in width along the said road and all trespasses on  
said lands which may be committed by the said Rail Road company  
or any other person whomsoever or so much as the said  
company may have or do for) Right and easement reserved  
to said proprietaries to said premises belonging or in any  
wise incident or pertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned to the said P. N. Fitch his heirs and assigns forever  
in fee simple against ourselves our heirs and assigns and against  
all other persons whomsoever or any of them carelessly claim-  
ing or to claim the said tract or parcel of land or any part  
thereof.
