Moyley of the State of South Carolina in the Greenville District of me and in consideration of the sum of Thirtynine dollars ab besides my natural love and affection for my son William D. Moyley to me in consideration of Chancery paid ab and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said William D. Moyley my son the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and deliver to the said William D. Moyley the following named negro slaves One boy named Abraham also Caroline, daughter of Eliza and Julia, daughter of Betty Price in number Do I swear and to God that the said three negro slaves above mentioned Tunc into the said William D. Moyley his executors, administrators and assigns to him and his esily proper use and behoof forever And I the said Sarah E. Moyley my executors and administrators the said bargaines purvey with the said William D. Moyley his executors and administrators and assigns from and against all persons shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal dated at Greenville on the ninth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four and in the 78th year of the Independence
