Whereas I Thresa Smith (widow of James
Waddell) of the State of South Carolina

make provision for my daughter Mary A. Smith now of the age of sixteen
years and for her children should she ever have any

Now therefore know all men by these presents that I the
said Thresa Smith do and in consideration of the natural love and affec-
tion which I have and bear towards my said daughter Mary A. Smith
and in further consideration of Five Dollars to me paid by Tillie C. Waddell
of the District and State of South Carolina have given, bargained sold and delivered
and by these presents do freely give, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said
Tillie C. Waddell a certain negro girl named Caroline aged about four
years. To go with all other things of the said negro girl
and Caroline to have and to hold the said negro girl Caroline
unto the said Tillie C. Waddell to the use and upon the special trust
and confidence as follows:

First I trust that the said negro girl Caroline shall
remain in my possession until the said Mary A. Smith shall marry a
husband or until my death if I
should die previous to the marriage or marriage of the said Mary A. Smith
and if the said Mary A. Smith should die before marriage or before attaining
to the age of twenty one years the negro girl Caroline shall then remain
in my possession until the time when the said Mary A. Smith would
have been Twenty one years of age had she lived.

Second I trust that upon the marriage of the said Mary
A. Smith or upon her attaining the age of Twenty one years or upon
my death, the said Tillie C. Waddell shall then hold the said negro girl
Caroline in trust and to the special use and benefit of the said Mary A.
Smith for and during the term of their natural life and during that term
shall permit the said Mary A. Smith to use possess and enjoy the said
negro girl Caroline and the profits thereof, free from all debt liability or
and a control of any husband of the said Mary A. Smith or of any
other person whomsoever.

Third I trust that if the said Mary A. Smith shall
leave issue of her body at her death the said Tillie C. Waddell shall
hold the said negro girl Caroline in trust for the said issue of the body
of the said Mary A. Smith for and during the term of their natural life
or lives.

Fourth I trust that if the said issue of the body of Mary
A. Smith or any of them shall die leaving issue of their body or bodies
but then the said negro girl Caroline shall rest in them and their heirs abs-
olutely forever.

Fifth I trust that if the said Mary A. Smith
shall die leaving no issue of her body, or if she die leaving issue
of her body and they die leaving no issue of their body or bodies
that then one half of the said negro girl Caroline shall rest absolutely
in my daughter Martha Ann Waddell and her heirs forever and
the said Tillie C. Waddell shall hold the other half of the said negro
