To all to whom these Presents shall come the sum of Two Thousand and Sixty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents to be paid to the said Eliza G^r Parkins in the sum of Two Thousand and Sixty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents to be paid to the said Eliza G^r Parkins one day after the date of said note and interest thereon to be paid to the said Eliza G^r Parkins by the said William H^e Jones as by reference to said note will more fully appear.

Know therefore that the said William H^e Jones for the better securing the payment of the said sum of Two Thousand and Sixty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents unto the said Eliza G^r Parkins her executors administrators and assigns together with lawful interest on the same from the fifth day of January 1854 have bargained and sold by the said William H^e Jones for the better securing the payment of the said sum of Two Thousand and Sixty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents unto the said Eliza G^r Parkins the negro slaves on marine blockade about thirty three years old and one named John about twenty three years old both of which slaves were purchased by me at the sale of the H^e Parkins debt estate in January 1853 they being to said estate previous to my purchase.

To have and hold the said negro slaves Nick and Bohm unto the said Eliza G^r Parkins her executors administrators and assigns forever provided always nevertheless that of the said William H^e Jones his executors administrators and assigns shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Eliza G^r Parkins the certain amount of executors administrators and assigns the full and just sum of Two Thousand and Sixty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents according to the true intent and meaning of the note aforesaid and of this present Agreement together with lawful interest on the same then thirled of bargain and sale and all and every clause and thing therein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void and of none effect any thing contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.

And it is hereby declared by and between the parties and the said William H^e Jones his executors administrators and assigns doth set covenant, promise and agree to and with the said Eliza G^r Parkins her executors administrators and assigns by these presents that if default shall happen to be made of or in payment of the said sum of Two Thousand and Sixty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents as aforesaid according to the true intent and meaning of the said note that then and in such case it shall be and may be lawful to and for the said Eliza G^r Parkins her executors administrators, attorneys and agents from time to time and at all times hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the messengers and instruments of the said William H^e Jones and to take the negroes mentioned into their custody and possession and the same to hold and detain to their own use and benefit (as their own proper goods and chattels) for the tenth and fourth or the same to sell and dispose of at will and pleasure.
