 I know all men by these presents that  
 James G McCburg of District of Greenville  
 in the State of South Carolina  
 defend love and affection I have and bear to my Son James H McCburg  
 Both of the Said State and district above mentioned have given  
 against granted bargained sold conveyed and released and by these  
 presents do give grant bargain sell convey and release unto the  
 intent said James H McCburg his heirs and assigns forever all that is last  
 held or partake of land being apart of the tract of land now lie on  
 pay <sup>containing</sup> of One hundred acres of land more or less situate  
 lying, and being in the District of Greenville and state aforesaid  
 in the waters of the Reedy fork a tributary of Reedy river being the  
 only part of the tract of land I now live on which was deeded to me  
 by Margaret McCburg to gather with all and singular the written  
 numbers hereditaments and appertaining to the said tract of land  
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to  
 hold all and singular the said premises unto the said James H  
 and McCburg his heirs and assigns for ever and I bind myself my  
 executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever  
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James H  
 and McCburg his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and  
 use against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to  
 any claim the same or any part ther of

I further give convey and deliver unto my  
 Said Son and his heirs One negro boy named Ben One  
 man One Cow and Calf One bed and furniture to have and  
 to hold the said negro boy man and Cow and Calf  
 bed and furniture unto the said James H McCburg and  
 his heirs forever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand and affixed my Seal this 8<sup>th</sup> of April A.D 1836  
 made and in the Eighteenth year of the Sovereignty and  
 independence of the United States of America  
 Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence  
 of Thomas Pashmon William Pashmon
