N A Feaster Trust Know all men by these presents
that I Thos Decatur Guin of Greenville

District State of So Ca for and in consideration of the natural
love and affection I bear to my beloved wife Laura Mc Guin
and of the fact that the Negro being after mentioned was given
to me by her Father Samuel G McLanahan Esqr and also
in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand
paid to me by Nathan A Feaster of Greenville District So Ca
have given alined and released unto the said N A Feaster
my right Title and interest in and to a certain Negro Slave
Girl named Emma about seventeen years old and her
child named Sims about one year old to have and to
hold the said Emma & Sims and her future increase to him
the said N A Feaster and his successors in the trust hereafter
mentioned against me and my heirs and every one
lawfully claiming under me forever. Now the express
understanding of the above gift is the following. To wit
that the said Negro Slave Emma & Sims shall be held by the said
N A Feaster for the especial use and benefit of my wife Laura
Mc Guin free and independent of all my future debts liabilities
and contracts or of all debts liabilities and contracts
of any future Husband she may here after have. Secondly
that the said N A Feaster may dispose of or change the
investment of the value in said Negroes Emma and her child
Sims & her increase or any part of the said increase in any
way which he may deem proper upon written application
to him from her instruction from me. Thirdly that the said
N A Feaster by and with the written consent or request
of my said wife may change the trustee ship in the said
Negroes Emma and Sims and her future increase at
any time they may deem proper by endorsement on this
paper. Fourthly that should the said N A Feaster die without
appointing a successor in this trust then my said wife may
in the foregoing manner appoint one herself. Independant
of further instructions from me. And Fifthly that my
said wife in anticipation of her death may dispose of the
said Negro Slaves Emma and Sims and her future increase
or the then corpus of the trust Estate in whatever shape it
may be by will and testament in any manner she may deem
proper as if she were a sole in law.

Given under my hand and seal on this the fifth day of
June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
and sixty and in the Eighty fourth year of the Independence
of the United States of America.

that I Elizabeth R Peden for & in consideration of the natural
love & affection which I have & bear towards my daughter
Martha Caroline Templeton & for & in consideration of Five
dollars to me in hand paid by Thadens McDuffe Templeton
husband of the said Martha Caroline have bargained
sold given & conveyed and by these presents do bargain
sell give & convey unto the said Thadens McDuffe Templeton
a negro girl named Edeline about ten years old in trust
for my said daughter Martha Caroline Templeton to
have & to hold the said negro girl Edeline & her increase
in trust for the sole & separate use of my said daughter
Martha Caroline Templeton during her life & at her death
to divide the said negro girl Edeline & all her increase
& issue equally amongst the children of my said daughter
Martha Caroline Templeton & the issue of such child or
children as may have died according to the Statutes of
Distribution in South Carolina & their heirs forever
and in case my said daughter Martha Caroline
Templiton should die without issue of her body living
at her death then & in that case the said negro girl
Edeline & all her increase & issue to be the absolute
right & property of my said son in law Thadens McDuffe
Templiton & his heirs forever
