 sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargained  
 sold and release unto the said John H Goodwin  
 a certain tract of Land situate in said District on the

 originally granted to John Nicol and containing One  
 hundred and forty six acres more or less Beginning on a  
 Pine 111x111x0 m N12 E43 chains to a chestnut 111x111x0 m thence  
 S62 W19.70 chs to a large Chestnut thence West 5 chs to a Stake  
 111x111x0 m thence S16 W to a poplar 111x111x0 m thence S35.  
 E33.10 chs to a pine 111x111x0 m thence N45 E27.75 to a Pine  
 the beginning corner bounded on the North by Jethel Gram  
 mells land on the East by Allens land and on South and  
 West by John H Goodwin and Allens Land, Together with  
 all and singular the rights members hereditaments, and  
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any  
 wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all  
 and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 John H Goodwin his heirs and assigns forever, and  
 I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators  
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
 premises unto the said John H Goodwin his heirs and assigns  
 against me and my heirs and against every person or  
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
 or any part thereof
