and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
hath given granted bargained and sold and by these
presents do give grant bargain and sell unto my son said
William McKinney the following Tracts or parcels of Land to
wit &c 1st The Tract known as the Calvin Goodlett Tract con-
taining Two Hundred and Sixty five acres be the same
more or less situate lying and being in the State and
District aforesaid on the waters of South Tyger River
bounded by Lands of Nancy McKinney O'Barrett
and others also Tract No 2 Known as the Holly Lands
containing One Hundred and fifty acres be the same
more or less situate lying and being in the State and
District aforesaid on the waters of Meader Fork Creek
a branch of South Tyger River bounded by Lands of William
Alloway Daniel McKinney and others also Tract No 3
that I bought as State Lands containing eighteen Acres
