Know all men by these presents
that I Vardry McBee of Greenville
District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration
of the interest I feel in the establishment of Southern Inde-
pendence, to me paid by the State of South Carolina
have granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
State of South Carolina a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being near the village of Greenville and bounded as
follows To wit Beginning on a Red oak corner of McB Duncan &
Jane Austin's land and runs south 7899 feet to a stake near
the Greenville & C R R R^d thence S40^W552 feet to a stake near
said G & C R R^d thence S47^W400 feet to a stake near said
R R R^d, thence S57^W430 feet to a stake near said R R R^d
thence N45^W547 feet to a stake in or near the center of
the Anderson Road, thence along said road N40^W655 feet to a stake in said road thence N34^W6440
feet to a stake in the edge of said Anderson Road &
near the stone corner of Jane Austin's lot, thence S72^W
& same course of Jane Austin's line 750 feet to the begin-
