and in consideration of the natural love and affection I bear
to my Sister Francis Mostello of the county of Hall and State of
Georgia do hereby give unto Henry Mostello a negro woman
named Mariah and her child Hobbit and their increase
in Trust for the sole separate and exclusive use of my said
Sister Francis Mostello and it is my wish that the said
negroes and their increase should remain with my said
sister during her natural life free from all liabilities
on account of any debts or contracts of her present or
any future husband, with remainder over to her children
living at the time of her death or to their representatives
or if after the death of my said sister it shall seem desirable
to sell the said negroes, the said Henry Mostello shall do
so and the proceeds arising from said sale shall be equally
divided amongst the children of my said sister or amongst
